FTA Europe, Intergraf and Smithers Pira hold successful Packaging Conference in Brussels

packaging Conference 2019 (website) brought together over 100 leading industry professionals from 22 countries to discuss business trends and regulatory issues facing the sector. Sponsored by GAMA International, TRESU Group and Kodak, the event held in Brussels on 21 February included presentations on sustainability, packaging innovation, and future product trends in the industry.

Speakers showcased the potential of packaging to respond to current challenges such as negative public perception of plastic packaging; ideas to improve the design to prolong the freshness of food; and advice on making the consumer experience of packaging easier and more engaging.

Of note, Kęstutis Sadauskas, Director for the Green Economy at the European Commission's DG Environment, announced that there will be a legislative revision to the Essential Requirements for Packaging, which is part of the EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Directive. Guidance on ecomodulation for Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) schemes will also be developed. Both proposals are expected by the end of 2019.

Over 100 participants joined the conference, proving a great opportunity to network and exchange industry best practice.

A report compiled by Intergraf/FTA Europe, which brings together the conclusions of the conference, will be shared with all Packaging Conference participants in the coming weeks.
