



## Smithers: Global packaging market forecasted to soar to \$1.42 trillion by 2028

In a recent <u>study</u> conducted by Smithers on 'The Future of Global Packaging to 2028,' the global packaging market is anticipated to witness significant growth, projecting a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 3.9% for the period 2023-2028. This surge is expected to propel the market to a staggering \$1.42 trillion by 2028.



## PLFTA: XRF analysis revolutionizes anilox roller condition assessment

by improper cleaning processes, have posed challenges. In response, a groundbreaking diagnostic method, based on X-ray fluorescence (XRF) analysis, has been developed, marking a significant advancement in understanding anilox roller conditions.

Traditional diagnostic methods, such as microscopic analysis and capacitive methods, have proven insufficient in providing a comprehensive assessment of anilox roller conditions. The newly developed XRF method goes beyond the limitations of existing techniques. By identifying chemical elements in both the core and working coating of the roller, the method allows for a precise determination of the state and thickness of the coating, focusing on elements such as Fe and Cr.

The key advantage of this method lies in its ability to detect minor damages on the roller's surface that may be invisible through other means, including microscopy. The study, conducted with a prototype and portable station equipped with an XRF module, demonstrated the method's potential as a quick, non-invasive, and easily applicable solution for assessing anilox roller conditions.

The research, a collaborative effort involving GRAW (The Polish Chamber of Flexographers's member) and NFAT (Natural Fibers Advanced Technologies) teams, showcased commitment and expertise of the teams involved.

The XRF method offers a safe and contactless

Anilox rollers play a pivotal role in the printing measurement process, providing valuable industry, and optimizing their properties has insights into anilox roller conditions. Its speed long been a focus of research. However, wear allows for more frequent routine inspections, and tear during regular use, often accelerated minimizing the risk of operating rollers with preliminary damage that could lead to irreversible issues.

# INKEY expands presence in French packaging market


